Bike riding is fun and good for us but everyone needs to practice safety. Here are some tips to remember when bicycling:

1. Check your bike over before you start. If any parts are loose or missing, don't ride the bike until it is repaired.

2. Only ride a bike that fits you. If you can stand up above the cross bar with both feet flat on the ground, and if you can sit comfortably on the seat with the ball of your foot on the lower pedal and your hands on the handlebar grips, then the bike is the proper size for you.

3. Always wear a helmet. A helmet may save your life if you fall or have an accident. A helmet should be CSA / ANSI or SNELL Foundation approved. It should fit snugly, and comfortably with the chinstrap done up. Wear your helmet level on your head with two fingers width above your eyebrows.
